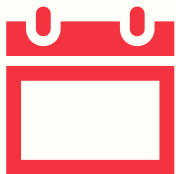

Honey Roasted Pumpkin

- 3 lb Fresh Pumpkin
- 2 Tbsp Honey
- 1 Tbsp Brown Sugar
- 1/3 tsp Ground Cinnamon
- 1/8 tsp Ground Nutmeg
- 1 tsp Kosher Salt
- 1/2 tsp Ground Black Pepper

1. Slice, peel and cube pumpkin. Combine with all ingredients and mix well to evenly coat.
2. Roast in an ovenproof dish at 350°F until tender and lightly golden brown and caramelized.
3. Serve and enjoy!
