Six Kimberly High School Students' Artwork Accepted in Congressional Art Competition Artist Discovery Contest Entries on Display at the Trout Art Museum May 6 to May 28

Students Emilie Dozer, Lauren Karmann, Corrine Vanevenhoven, Brooke Mahoney, Greg De Witt, and Emma Gingras have their artwork on display at the Trout Art Museum through May 28, 2017, as part of the "Artistic Discovery Contest."

The Artistic Discovery Contest is open to high school students in Wisconsin's 8th Congressional District. These six students will be representing Kimberly High School, and will have their work shown at the Trout Art Museum in Appleton.

The opening reception for this show will be held on Sunday, May 21, 2017, at 1:00pm, where the winner for this district will be announced. The winner of the local contest will be invited to a reception in Washington, D.C. for the unveiling of their artwork, which will be displayed in the U.S. Capitol for one year.

This exhibit will include all of the nation-wide winning entries. Along with being featured in the U.S. Capitol, students with the winning entries will also qualify for a scholarship.
