Crime Scene Investigation - Combined 2 & 3

Fox Valley Technical College will create a simulated experience where students will be able to investigate a mock crime scene, collect evidence, and try to determine who committed a crime. On day 2, students will get a chance to challenge their critical thinking skills by taking part in an Escape Room.

Relax and Unwind

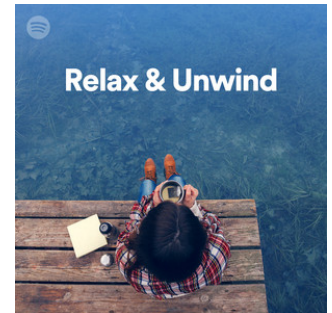

I Want to Be Rich

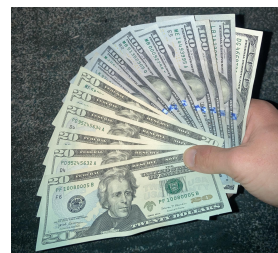
