## Free & Reduced-Price Meal Applications – 2023-2024 School Year

School meals continue to be some of the healthiest meal options for students and are an important part of the learning day. Our goal is to continue to support all students and families by ensuring those who need free or reduced priced meals at school continue to receive them. It is critical that all families complete a short, confidential application and turn it in to ensure there are no gaps in meal benefits.

- For families with multiple students in the district, only one household application is needed, and benefits will apply for the entire school year.
- Should your household financial circumstances change at any time, applications can also be submitted throughout the year.
- For families receiving other benefits, such as SNAP or TANF, you may receive notification that your student(s) is/are automatically eligible for free meals and need not submit an application.
