ANNUAL UPDATE

The "Annual Update" process opens August 1st– August 15th, for all families for the 2023-24 school year.

This process replaces the forms you have filled out at school in the past and is required by all families. This process will guide you through



updating and reviewing information for the upcoming school year and must be completed by the primary Parent/Guardian. <u>Student schedules are</u> also viewable on August 1st.

Annual Update can be completed by accessing the <u>Infinite Campus Parent Portal</u> on the web. If you do not have an Infinite Campus Parent Portal account or have forgotten your username or password, please visit our <u>Infinite Campus webpage</u>.

PICTURES

Sunrise Elementary has its picture day on Wednesday, August 2nd 11am-6pm. If that date doesn't work for you, no problem, 4K-8th grade students can go to any KASD school for their picture (9-12 graders must go to KHS). Click <u>HERE</u> to see all available dates and locations, sign up for a time-slot and prepay for your pictures.



There will be no collections of fees or paperwork on picture day and encourage you to pay your school fees online starting August 1st. When paying through Infinite Campus, you are now able to pay using the e-check method or by using your credit card. Credit card fees for registration will be waved August 1st-September 31st. Please remember when you use an e-check it is similar to using a paper check and if this check would be rejected by your bank due to non-sufficient funds, you will be charged a \$25 NSF fee.

Picture re-takes will take place on Tuesday, September 26th during the school day for those students who are unable to attend.

TEACHER ASSIGNMENTS

CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS

Beginning August 1st you will be able to access the name of your child's teacher by logging onto your Infinite Campus account. Once in Infinite Campus, click on your child's name, then click **SCHEDULE**.

If your child has two teachers listed: for students in grades 1 and 2, the AM attendance will indicate your child's literacy teacher, and the PM attendance will indicate their primary teacher. For students in grade 3, the AM attendance will indicate your child's primary teacher, and the PM attendance will indicate their literacy teacher.

SCHOOL FEES

Beginning August 1st next years fees and hot lunch account will be available in Infinite Campus. At that time you may make payment online by accessing your Infinite Campus account. When paying through Infinite Campus, you are now able to pay using the e-check method or by using your credit card. Credit card fees for registration will be waved August 1st-September 31st. Please remember when you use an e-check it is similar to using a paper check and if this check would be rejected by your bank due to non-sufficient funds, you will be charged a \$25 NSF fee. Families are encouraged to complete the Free and Reduced Lunch Applications here and Fee Waivers as needed.


