PICTURE DAY



Woodland Elementary has its picture day tomorrow, Wednesday, August 9th from 7:30 am until 12:30 pm and 2:00 pm until 5:00 pm. If that date doesn't work for you, 4K-8th grade students can go to any KASD school for their picture (9-12 graders must go to KHS). Click <u>HERE</u> to see all available dates and locations, sign up

for a time-slot and prepay for your pictures. Classrooms will not be open on picture day.

There will be no collections of fees or paperwork on picture day and we encourage you to pay your school fees online. When paying through <u>Infinite Campus</u>, you are now able to pay using the e-check method or by using your credit card. Credit card fees for registration will be waved through September 31st. Please remember when you use an e-check it is similar to using a paper check and if this check would be rejected by your bank due to non-sufficient funds, you will be charged a \$25 NSF fee. Picture re-takes will take place on Wednesday, October 4th during the school day for those students who are unable to attend a picture day.

MEET YOUR TEACHER/SUPPLY DROP OFF

Meet Your Teacher is scheduled for Wednesday, August 30th between 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm. This is a great opportunity to come in to meet your teacher and drop off school supplies prior to the first day of school. PICK-UP & DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

Students planning to arrive and depart school using our contracted bus service, Lamers Bus Lines, may access bus route information through <u>Infinite Campus</u> one week prior to school starting. Please contact Lamers Bus Lines with any questions about your child's route information.

Students taking an alternate form of transportation to school should arrive no earlier than 8:25 AM at which point we will have them go directly to their classrooms to start the day.

Parents who have to see the office staff may enter the office as usual. The same procedures will apply in the PM. Parents may wait outside for their children to join them at the conclusion of the school day.

All 5K Pick-Up and Drop-Offs will occur at the end of our 5K hallway, near the 5K playground. Please click <u>here</u> to access the 5K pick-up and drop-off procedures. Parents may park in the main parking lot and doors will open at 8:25 AM, and again at 3:35 PM. Student exchanges will occur outside the door with the assistance of our 5K staff.

If a child has to leave during the day (i.e. appointments, etc.), parents may enter the office as usual and the office staff will call down to have the child meet their parents.

EARLY DISMISSAL EXPLANATIONS

NOON DISMISSAL

All students are dismissed at 12:00 pm — Lunch is not served — The Y-Care Staff is here for those signed up for Y-Care. Please bring a lunch for your child if they will be staying with the Y-Care program. There is no care provided after NOON by our Woodland Elementary staff.

Early School Dismissals!

2:00 PM DISMISSAL (Fridays)

Students are dismissed at 2:00 PM — If your child is signed up to stay for the movie, they will need to be picked up any time between 2:00 pm and 3:35 pm. Y-Care begins at 3:35 pm for those students who are signed up for Y-Care.

2:00 PM DISMISSAL (PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES)

ALL Students are dismissed at 2:00 PM — there is NO CARE PROVIDED by our staff on these days. Y-Care families need to contact the YMCA to "sign-up" for Y-Care on conference days. Thank you!



NOTES FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

MEDICATION INFORMATION

Medication consent forms are required for all over-the-counter and prescription medications. This includes cough drops, ointments, creams, etc. **Prescription medications do require a physicians signature.** You may find these forms on the KASD website by clicking <u>HERE</u>.

HEALTH/BUS INFORMATION

Does your child have a health condition that requires you to fill out and return a "Health Services" form for a condition such as asthma, food allergies, seizures, diabetes, bee sting allergy, etc., to your child's school? Please be aware that the information will be shared with Lamers Bus Company by the beginning of October, 2023.
