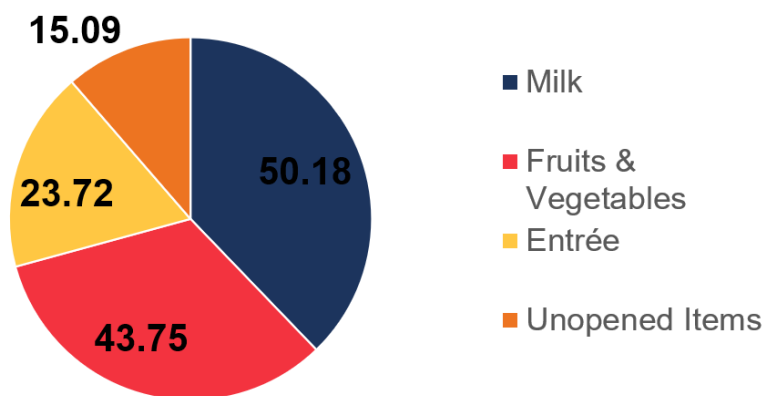
Looking for Menus?
