## IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

## In a shelter

In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station

Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship

> Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

## Your eligible children have the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
- Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents.
- Enroll in the local school; or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference.
* If the school district believes that the school you select is not in the best interest of your children, then the district must provide you with a written explanation of its position and inform you of your right to appeal its decision.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
- Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your children's needs.

If you believe your children may be eligible, contact the local liaison to find out what services and supports may be available. There also may be supports available for your preschool-age children.

We are encouraging school and community members to become the eyes and ears of the Kimberly Area School District in order to provide information that keeps our students, staff and schools safe.

It sometimes can be difficult to define:

- Take your time to pay attention to your surroundings and to the behaviors of others around you.
- Know what suspicious or concerning behaviors look like.
- Does the activity look strange to you?
- Are you worried someone you know is thinking about hurting others or themselves?


## Report it, don't just repeat it.

## COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Keep your child home when:

- They are sick (If experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, testing is recommended regardless of vaccination status.)
- They are diagnosed with COVID-19
- They are being tested for COVID-19

COVID protocols vary on a case-by-case basis, but are based on CDC/Wisconsin DHS guidelines. For detailed guidance, see CDC website. Generally however, protocols will be:

## IF MY CHILD... THEN HE/SHE/THEY SHOULD...

## Option 1:

- Isolate for 5 days

Tests positive for COVID-19 regardless of vaccination status

- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are significantly improved, you can return to school on day 6
- Wear a mask for days 6 to 10

Option 2:

- Isolate for 10 days, return on day 11


## Option 1:

- Quarantine for 5 days after the last contact with a positive case. Test on day 5 and with a negative result return on day 6 (provide a copy of the lab report negative result to the office)

Was exposed to COVID-19 and are NOT *up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccinations

- Continue to wear a mask for days 6 to 10


## Option 2:

- Quarantine for 10 days after the last contact with a positive case, return on day 11

Was exposed to COVID-19
and are *up-to-date on

- Remain in school and monitor for symptoms for 10 days

COVID-19 vaccinations

- Mask for 10 days

Was exposed to COVID-19
and had COVID-19 in last 90 days

- Remain in school and monitor for symptoms for 10 days
- Mask for 10 days
