# Lawrence Academy Girl Choir

## \*AUDITIONS FOR NEW MEMBERS

Lawrence Academy of Music Girl Choir auditions for NEXT school year's choirs (2022-2023 school year) are happening soon! Choirs meet once a week from September-December and January-March.

The Academy Girl Choir program provides the opportunity for girls to use their voice in a community setting. Through the study and performance of the highest quality music, the singers develop vocal technique, musical skills, creativity, expressive artistry, and an awareness of various cultures. The Girl Choir Program creates an atmosphere that encourages singers to respect the uniqueness of others, to take risks that foster individual growth, and to continue their development into self-assured adults. In a typical year, we have approximately 300 girls in the Girl Choir Program who come from public, parochial, and home schools throughout Northeast Wisconsin.

### **Primo: Grades 3-5 (currently in grades 2-4)**

The Primo curriculum introduces large group rehearsal processes. Singers learn choral rehearsal and performance skills, how to read choral music and how to sing as a choir in unison. Primo performs in the Lawrence Memorial Chapel.

### **Allegretto: Grades 4-6 (currently in grades 3-5)**

The Allegretto curriculum strengthens the basics of choral singing. Singers learn basic rhythmic and melodic reading skills, healthy vocal production and breathing skills, and how to sing as a choir in unison and two parts. Allegretto performs in the Lawrence Memorial Chapel, plus one community performance.

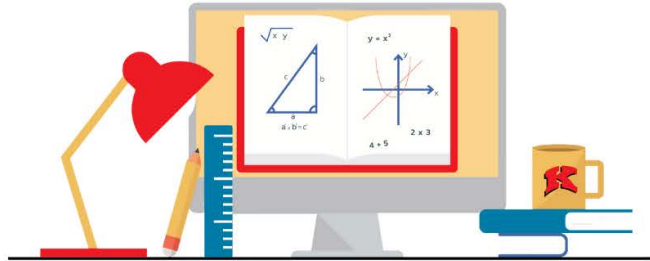

2. Birthdates are confirmed through the Wisconsin Immunization Registry. For non-immunized students or students registering from out of state an ORIGINAL birth certificate must be brought in at some point after you have registered online. The birth certificate can be brought to any of the schools listed on the right or KASD's District Office.

The Kimberly Area School District takes a nurturing approach to 4K and 5K development. It is expected, as with all grades, that students will be ready for the next grade level at the end of the school year.

# INFORMATION FOR PARENTS



## IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

In a shelter



In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation



In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station



Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship

*Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.*

### Your eligible children have the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
  - Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
  - Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents.
  - Enroll in the local school; or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference.
- \* If the school district believes that the school you select is not in the best interest of your children, then the district must provide you with a written explanation of its position and inform you of your right to appeal its decision.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
  - Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your children's needs.

*If you believe your children may be eligible, contact the local liaison to find out what services and supports may be available. There also may be supports available for your preschool-age children.*

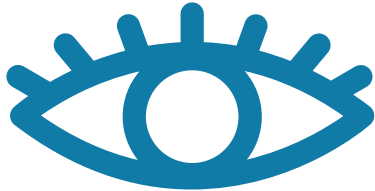

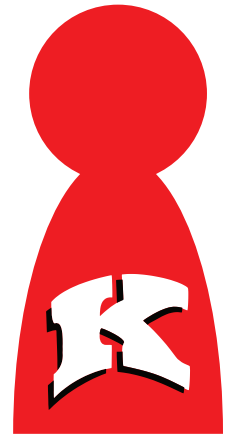

# COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Keep your child home when:

- They are sick (If experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, testing is recommended regardless of vaccination status.)
- They are diagnosed with COVID-19
- They are being tested for COVID-19

COVID protocols vary on a case-by-case basis, but are based on CDC/Wisconsin DHS guidelines. For detailed guidance, see [CDC website](#). Generally however, protocols will be:

Tests positive for COVID-19 regardless of vaccination status	<p><b>Option 1:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Isolate for 5 days</li><li>• If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are significantly improved, you can return to school on day 6</li><li>• Wear a mask for days 6 to 10</li></ul> <p><b>Option 2:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Isolate for 10 days, return on day 11</li></ul>
Was exposed to COVID-19 and are NOT *up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccinations	<p><b>Option 1:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Quarantine for 5 days after the last contact with a positive case. Test on day 5 and with a negative result return on day 6 (provide a copy of the lab report negative result to the office)</li><li>• Continue to wear a mask for days 6 to 10</li></ul> <p><b>Option 2:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Quarantine for 10 days after the last contact with a positive case, return on day 11</li></ul>
Was exposed to COVID-19 and are *up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccinations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Remain in school and monitor for symptoms for 10 days</li><li>• Mask for 10 days</li></ul>
Was exposed to COVID-19 and had COVID-19 in last 90 days	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Remain in school and monitor for symptoms for 10 days</li><li>• Mask for 10 days</li></ul>

*\*Up-to-date: A person is considered up-to-date after completing their COVID primary vaccination series.*
