Medication at School

Prescription Medication: You must have a physician's signature AND parent/guardian signature on the required form.

Over-the-Counter Medication (including cough drops and ointments, etc.): Only parent/guardian signature is necessary on the required form.

Medication Forms: are available by <u>clicking HERE</u> or in the school office. ALL medications MUST come to school in the original container-thank you!

Health/Bus Information: Does your child have a health condition that requires you to fill out and return a "Health Services" form for a condition such as asthma, food allergies, seizures, diabetes, bee sting allergy, etc., to your child's school? Please be aware that the information will be shared with Lamers Bus Company by the beginning of October, 2022. **IMPORTANT:** If you feel that your child's condition warrants more immediate notification to Lamers, please call them at 920-832-8800.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

- Our school day runs from 8:35 AM-3:35 PM
- Drop-off begins at 8:25, unless a student is coming to breakfast—breakfast drop off is at 8:00. Pick-up is at 3:35. Additional important drop-off and pick-up details are included on a flyer and map attached to this newsletter.

CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS

You will be able to view the name of your child's teacher in <u>Infinite Campus</u> beginning on **Monday**, **August 1st at 9:00 am.** Once you are in Infinite Campus, click on your child's name, then click on **Schedule** (on the left side).

Please note that the KASD policy is to no longer post full class lists prior to the school year starting.

Literacy Teachers - In order to reduce class sizes, and to offer literacy intervention, the KASD has provided an additional literacy teacher for first, second, and third grades. If your child has two different teachers listed, that means he or she will have one teacher in the morning for literacy and another teacher in the afternoon. This has been a long time practice in the KASD allowing our youngest students to get off to a good start in becoming successful readers and writers. For students in grades 1 & 2, the AM attendance will indicate your child's literacy teacher, while the literacy teacher for students in grade 3 will be indicated by the PM attendance.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

Beginning the week of August 1st, you will be able to see your bus information in the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. You can find this information under "More" and the area "Bus Transportation." As in past years, Lamers Transportation will also be sending out letters with this information. Please contact Lamers Bus Services at 920-832-8800 ext. 2 with any questions. Please do not call the district with questions regarding your routes, as we do not have this information.

EARLY DISMISSAL EXPLANATIONS

NOON DISMISSAL All students are dismissed at 12:00 PM — Lunch is not served — The Y-Care Staff is here for those signed up for Y-Care. Please bring a lunch for your child if he/she will be staying with the Y-Care program. There is no care provided after NOON by our Westside staff.

<u>2:00 PM DISMISSAL (Fridays)</u> Students are dismissed at 2:00 PM — If your child is signed up to stay for the movie, he/she will need to be picked up any time between 2:00 and 3:35—Y-Care begins at 3:35 for those students who are signed up for Y-Care.

<u>2:00 PM DISMISSAL (PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES)</u> ALL Students are dismissed at 2:00 PM — there is **NO CARE PROVIDED** by our staff on these days. Y-Care families need to contact the YMCA to "sign-up" for Y-Care on conference days.

Drop-off Procedures

- Breakfast starts at 8:00 AM Enter the main entrance (Entrance #1S) and proceed downstairs to the cafeteria.
- Drop-off starts at 8:25 AM Students should arrive no earlier than 8:25 AM at which point they will go directly to their classrooms.
- Non-handicapped vehicles are not allowed in the circle drive from 8:15 8:35 am.
- 5K students will enter the front lower entrance of the building (**Entrance #3S**) near the lower playground, using the outside stairs.
- 1st grade students will enter the main entrance in the front of the building (Entrance #1S).
- 2nd grade students will enter near the front/southeast side of the building (**Entrance** #15E).
- 3rd grade students will enter the rear/north side of the building (Entrance #11N).
- 4th grade students will enter near the rear of the building (Entrance #12E).


Breakfast Drop Off begins at 8:00am.

Pick-up Procedures

- We have supervised pick-up that starts at 3:35pm.
- Non-handicapped vehicles are not allowed in the circle drive from 3:30 3:45 pm.
- Parents have to wait outside the building to pick up their children.
- ALL 5K will dismiss "hand to hand" or on eye contact in the **rear/northside of the** building from ENTRANCE #10N & #11N.
- 1st grade students will be released out the front of the building-main entrance or ramp.
- 2nd students will be released out of the front/southeast door.
- 3rd grade students will be released from their classrooms and can leave the building from any exit.
- 4th grade students will be released out of the rear/northeast door.
- Parents must plan where they will meet their children outside the building.
