UPDATE FROM OUR KASD BOARD OF EDUCATION

On Monday, October 25, 2021, the Kimberly Area School District (KASD) Board of Education voted in favor of the following to align with vaccination availability for students:

- Starting November 1, masking will be optional in grades 7-12.
- Starting January 3, masking will be optional in grades 4K-6.

KASD will continue to follow our current mitigation strategies and adopt a masking criteria at a 2% covid positivity by building. If the 2% threshold is met, a building will be required to mask for 14 days and a review of cases and spread will be conducted.


Media Resource For Parents - from Officer Stahmann

Part of my responsibility as your child's School Resource Officer is to connect parents with resources. This article is for families with children that have their own phone or tablet.

Parents have a responsibility to educate your child on being a good digital citizen, which includes appropriate, responsible behavior of your child while on a device. The biggest influence on a child's online behavior are frequent discussions held within the family. Just as you taught your child how to ride a bike before giving them a bike, you are responsible for teaching your child how to navigate the digital world prior to giving them their own device. Part of that responsibility is monitoring/restricting your child's device usage. To help you with that, Google has "Family Link" and Apple has "Screen Time" for parents.

Family Link is an app that is downloaded onto your child's device as well as your device. Apple created Screen Time, which is found in "Settings" on your device. Both options have similar features, which include:

- Viewing the device location on a map.
- Restricting the type of content your child can view on the internet.
- The requirement to approve the download of any app on your child's device.
- Removing/disabling apps from your child's device.
- Locking your child's device.
- Viewing the amount of time spent on each app per day.
- Setting a daily limit of time spent on the device before it locks.
- Setting a "bedtime" for the device so that it locks.



These options, combined with frequent discussions, make for a healthy and safe online presence for your child. WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

Winter is right around the corner. If weather conditions dictate that there will be no school or a delayed start, a decision to keep the schools closed is usually made by 6:00 a.m. Parents with students in school receive a direct call, text and/or email from our auto-call system through Infinite Campus since that is the fastest way to communicate with thousands of parents at one time.

As a reminder: If you have a new phone number or email address, please update your information in the Infinite Campus parent portal or contact your school's secretary to update the portal. Also, weather alerts go out using the "General Notification" make sure you have the "General" box checked when verifying your Infinite Campus notifications.

Announcements are also sent to local T.V. and radio stations, please tune to local stations such as these rather than call the school directly: WAPL-105.7FM, WIXX-101.1FM, WHBY-103.5FM, WKFX-104.9FM, WEMI-91.9 FM, WTAQ-97.5FM/1360AM, WWWX-96.9FM and WGEE-93.5FM; and WBAY-TV2, WFRV-TV5, WGBA-TV26, and WLUK-FOX11. If other school events, such as concerts or sporting events are also cancelled because of weather, they are typically communicated through these stations as well.

The District's website and Facebook page are not our primary way to communicate school closures, so we ask parents to listen to the auto-call messages or tune in to the radio and T.V. stations listed for the timeliest updates.

PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES FOR GRADES 5K-4TH

PTCFast.com will make sign-ups as convenient as possible. To schedule your preferred time for a parent/teacher conference:

- 3. Enter student information.
- 4. Enter parent information.
- 5. After entering your information, you will receive an email with a link to select the date and time of the conference.

Specials teachers will also be available via google meet during specific times on November 11 and November 15.



COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

When monitoring for COVID-19 symptoms, parents/guardians and students should look for:

<u>Major symptoms</u> (Students should stay home and take a COVID-19 test if ONE symptom from this list is present): Fever (above 100.4), cough (above baseline), new loss of taste/smell, trouble breathing/shortness of breath

<u>Minor symptoms</u> (Students should stay home and take a COVID-19 test if TWO symptoms from this list are present): Congestion/runny nose (above baseline), chills, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, headache (above baseline), body aches, unusual fatigue, sore throat (above baseline)



- They are diagnosed with COVID-19
- They are being tested for COVID-19

COVID protocols vary on a case-by-case basis, but are based on CDC/Wisconsin DHS guidelines. Generally however, protocols will be:

INFORMATION For Parents



IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

In a shelter

In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation

*

In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station

Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship

Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

Your eligible children have the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
- Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents.
- Enroll in the local school; or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference.
 - * If the school district believes that the school you select is not in the best interest of your children, then the district must provide you with a written explanation of its position and inform you of your right to appeal its decision.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
- Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your children's needs.

If you believe your children may be eligible, contact the local liaison to find out what services and supports may be available. There also may be supports available for your preschool-age children.
