As we enter November this year we are also entering our 8th month of the COVID-19 Pandemic. This pandemic has flipped all of our lives upside down. Times are tough for all of us in different ways. November is a month of Thanksgiving, and is here to remind us to be thankful for what we do have.

At Westside we have so much to be thankful for! Let's start with the obvious. We are teaching and learning AT school! The state of Wisconsin has around 1,200 elementary schools and approximately 200 have students in person right now. Media Resource For Parents - from Officer Stahmann

Part of my responsibility as your child's School Resource Officer is to connect parents with resources. This article is for families with children that have, or will have, their own tablet and/or smartphone.

Those that do, have a responsibility as a parent to educate your child on being a good digital citizen, which includes appropriate, responsible behavior of your child while on a device. Just as you teach your child how to ride a bike before giving them a bike, you are responsible for teaching your child how to navigate the digital world prior to giving them their own device. Part of that responsibility is monitoring your child's device usage. To help you with that, both Google and Apple have features that make your job much easier.

Google created an app called FamilyLink. The app is downloaded onto your child's device as well as your device, and it gives the parent access to a number of awesome features. Apple's software update includes ScreenTime. Those features include:

Viewing the device location on a map.

Restricting the type of content your child can view on the internet.

The requirement to approve the download of any app on your child's device.

Removing/disabling apps from your child's device.

Locking your child's device.

Viewing the amount of time spent on each app per day.

Setting a daily limit of time spent on the device before it locks.

Setting a "bedtime" for the device so that it locks.

I'm not an advocate for any particular company, operating system, device, etc. I'm advocating for safer children. Parent involvement in their child's digital citizenship starting at an early age plays a critical role in that. As always, please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.

VIRTUAL Parent Teacher Conferences—2:00 Dismissal — No Movie

On Parent Teacher conference days (November 12 & 16) ALL students are dismissed at 2:00 PM — there is **NO CARE PROVIDED (no movie)** on these days, as our teachers are preparing for conferences which start at 5:00.

All children will be dismissed at 2:00.

Y-Care families need to contact the YMCA to sign-up for Y-Care on conference days.

IMPORTANT UPDATE: *Switching from In Person to Online Instruction*

Originally the district offered parents and students the opportunity to switch to online instruction at any time. As the district continues to respond to changing conditions, that approach must be adjusted.

Beginning on October 12, 2020 students will be allowed to switch into online learning **only at the Quarter mark**. Parents should give at minimum a two week notice of their intention so that the district has time to prepare.

- Start of Quarter 3: Monday, January 18, 2021 (Requests must be received by January 4)
- Start of Quarter 4: Tuesday, March 23, 2021 (Requests must be received by March 9)

There are two reasons for this change. First, space in the online program is becoming very limited, and we can no longer support continual and ongoing changes. Secondly, students switching at random times are experiencing too great a disruption in their learning experience. For the sake of the students' learning, it is better to switch at a defined stopping point like quarter/semester.

As has been the case since the start of the school year, students are allowed to switch back to in person learning at the beginning of the quarter only.

We thank everyone for your understanding as we continue to balance the safety of our community with the high quality learning experience we have here in Kimberly.

WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

Winter is right around the corner. If weather conditions dictate that there will be no school or a delayed start, a decision to keep the schools closed is usually made by 6:00 a.m. Parents with students in school receive a direct call, text and/or email from our auto-call system through Infinite Campus since that is the fastest way to communicate with thousands of parents at one time.

As a reminder: If you have a new phone number or email address, please update your information in the Infinite Campus parent portal or contact your school's secretary to update the portal. Also, weather alerts go out using the "General Notification" make sure you have the "General" box checked when verifying your Infinite Campus notifications.

Announcements are also sent to local T.V. and radio stations, please tune to local stations such as these rather than call the school directly: WAPL-105.7FM, WIXX-101.1FM, WHBY-103.5FM, WKFX-104.9FM, WEMI-91.9 FM, WTAQ-97.5FM/1360AM, WWWX-96.9FM and WGEE-93.5FM; and WBAY-TV2, WFRV-TV5, WGBA-TV26, and WLUK-FOX11. If other school events, such as concerts or sporting events are also cancelled because of weather, they are typically communicated through these stations as well.

The District's website and Facebook page are not our primary way to communicate school closures, so we ask parents to listen to the auto-call messages or tune in to the radio and T.V. stations listed for the timeliest updates.



NOVEMBER LIFE SKILLS



Our Protective Behaviors Program (teaching children a variety of safety life skills) will be presented during the month of November to 5K through 4th grade students.

Through these presentations and discussions, students will become more aware about the world around them, physical and sexual abuse, safety with strangers, and what to do when home alone. Students will learn basic age appropriate methods for protecting themselves against unwanted physical touch and establishing a network of trusted adults that they can contact when needed.

We would ask you and encourage you to make some time this month and discuss your personal views and rules on staying safe. Working together we can help children better protect themselves.

Home connection: Ask your student(s) about **Mindfulness!**

This time of year we are usually preparing for the Guinness World Records Speed Stacking "Stack Up" event in which we have a gym full of stacking and building. This year our event will look quite different, but we still do plan to participate.

This year the record will involve sending in photos of students stacking, and the photos will be used to try to set the **Guinness World Record Title for the World's Largest Online Photo Album of Speed Stacks!**

I will be taking photos of our Westside students participating in Speed Stacking lessons November 2nd-13th. Then, I will submit the photos on November 18th.



WHEN TO STAY HOME FROM SCHOOL

Keep your child home when:

- ✓ They are sick (please see [student illness guide](#) and when to get tested)
- ✓ They are diagnosed with COVID-19
- ✓ They are being tested for COVID-19
- ✓ They are a [close contact](#) of someone with COVID-19



Frequently Asked Questions:

Do I keep my child home if someone in my household is being tested for COVID-19?

A: Send your child to school if your child is symptom free.

OR

A: Keep your child home if your child has COVID-like symptoms.

Do I keep my child home from school if someone in my household is a close contact of a confirmed case of COVID-19?

A: Send your child to school if the household member who is the close contact is symptom free.

OR

A: Keep your child home if the household member who is the close contact has COVID-like symptoms. (The household member who is the close contact is considered a probable case of COVID if he/she is showing symptoms while awaiting test results and everyone in your household at that point is considered a close contact and will need to quarantine.)

STUDENT ILLNESS GUIDE AND WHEN TO GET TESTED

People with the below symptoms or combination of symptoms may have COVID-19. The table below outlines WI-DHS recommendations of who should receive COVID-19 testing in Wisconsin. If you have these symptoms, **stay home, call your school office and get tested.**

Box A (any one symptom present)

- Cough (above baseline) Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing New loss of taste or smell

OR

Box B (any two symptoms present)

- Congestion or runny nose (above baseline) Chills or fever (100.4) Nausea or vomiting
 Diarrhea Fatigue Muscle or body aches Sore throat (above baseline)

**If you choose not to get tested, you must remain home until at least 10 days have passed since symptom onset AND at least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without use of medicine AND other symptoms have improved.*

OR

Box C

- I am a close contact of someone with COVID-19

WI-DHS recommends getting tested if you are a close contact. If you test negative during your quarantine period, you will still need to complete your full 14-day quarantine before it is safe to go back to school or be around others

For all other illnesses, follow typical school illness protocol by staying home, calling the school office and once your child is 24 hour symptom free they may return.



CLOSE CONTACT GUIDE

What does it mean to be a close contact of someone with COVID-19?

You are a “close contact” if any of the following situations happened while you spent time with the person with COVID-19, even if they didn't have symptoms:

- ✓ Had direct physical contact with the person (for example, a hug, kiss, or handshake)
- ✓ Were within 6 feet of the person for more than 15 minutes
- ✓ Had contact with the person's respiratory secretions (for example, coughed or sneezed on; contact with dirty tissue; shared a drinking glass, food, towels, or other personal items)
- ✓ Live with the person or stayed overnight for at least one night in a household with the person



EXAMPLE

Your child was playing outside with a neighborhood friend when he drank from the friend's water bottle without thinking. The following day, the friend developed symptoms and subsequently tested positive for COVID-19. **Your child is a close contact.**

EXAMPLE

I went out to eat with a friend yesterday and we were within 6 feet of each other for 30 minutes. The following day my friend tested positive for COVID-19. I am now a close contact. What about my child? **Your child is NOT a close contact** as your child did not spend time with your friend.

If you had contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 you may be at risk of infection. Follow these recommendations for 14 days since your last close contact with someone with COVID-19. It is important to **self-quarantine and self-monitor** to protect yourself, your family, and your community.



As a close contact, what does it mean to quarantine?



- Stay home
- Avoid travel
- Go out only if absolutely necessary
- Postpone all non-essential medical appointments until your quarantine is over
- Do not use public transportation, ride-sharing, or taxis
- Wear a face cover when you are around others
