2:00 DISMISSAL: This FRIDAY, September 16 is a 2:00 PM dismissal. If your child is signed up to stay for the movie in the gym on 2:00 dismissal days, your child will go to the gym at 2:00. Students can be picked up from the movie any time between 2:00 and 3:35. If your child attends Y-Care at Westside, he/she will be escorted to Y-Care at 3:30. All students must be picked up at 3:35. 
#### MINDFULNESS CENTERS




