
(Network Photographers are not allowed under any circumstances to touch students!)

# IF SECOND TIME BEING PHOTOGRAPHED:

Students must return original packet of photos to photographer on re-take day in order to receive a replacement package\*

 Re-take day orders will be sent to the school within 2-3 weeks.



# **ORDERING LATER:**

Students that did not order on initial or re-take photo days can order all school year long by using the web password provided on a proof card send to the school. Late orders will be shipped directly to home.

# BEFORE PICTURE DAY

**ONLINE PRE-PAY OPTION** 

Parents can use the online pre-pay link provided by the school to place an order before picture day. This is the preferred and most efficient way for parents to get orders placed.

# DAY PICTURES ARE TAKEN

-Parents can use the Online Pre-Pay Option

-Parents can use a printed order form and give to photographer

-Parents can scan the QR code at school location and place an order

# **48 HOURS AFTER PICTURE DAY**

-Parents can use the online pre-pay link provided by the school to place an order up to 48 hours after the school picture date.

# ORDERING AFTER PICTURE DAY

-Parents can call the Network Photography office to place an order and have it shipped with the other orders going to the school if it has not left the building. There is no shipping charge with this method.

-Parents can use the web password provided for their student on a proof/re-order card. This card is sent to the school for every student photographed about 3 weeks after picture day.

-The proof/re-order card contains the student's image and password and may be used to order photo's anytime for the rest of the school year. Photos ordered online after picture day get mailed directly to the home and include a shipping charge.




- For families with multiple students in the district, only one household application is needed, and benefits will apply for the entire school year.

National Pepperoni Pizza Day on September 20<sup>th</sup> gives us a reason to enjoy a hot slice pizza topped with America's favorite pizza topping!






# FARE Check Certification 2022

# **COVID-19 STRATEGIES FOR EVERYDAY OPERATIONS**

Kimberly Area School District is taking a variety of actions every day to prevent the spread of infectious diseases, including the virus that causes COVID-19. From the start of the pandemic new tools have become available to limit the effect of COVID-19 on communities and healthcare systems. As a result the CDC and Wisconsin Department of Public Health Services have shifted their COVID response.

KASD is adopting the COVID Strategies listed below, which are supported by our local public health department. These strategies may be revised depending on updated information and guidance from the CDC and Wisconsin Department of Public Health Service.

III or have COVID- like symptoms	<ul> <li>Stay home, for more details see When to Keep Your Child Home</li> <li>Return to school after 24 hours fever-free without fever reducing medications</li> </ul>
Positive for COVID	<ul> <li>Stay home from school for 5 days after symptoms begin, AND</li> <li>Return to school after 24 hours fever-free without fever reducing medications</li> </ul>
General Mitigation	<ul> <li>Increased air ventilation;</li> <li>Standard surface cleaning;</li> <li>Handwashing; and</li> <li>Respiratory etiquette</li> </ul>
Masking	Optional, Students/Staff may mask at any time
