A Message from our Principal

Happy Spring Westside Families!

As I write this newsletter the forecast is set for 58, and it feels like 30 and most of my 4th grade boys are in shorts and t-shirts! Good news, the boys will be just fine and it will get warmer, it always does...by July!

Spring in Wisconsin brings inconsistent weather conditions, stir crazy elementary students and STANDARDIZED TESTING! Westside started the Forward test in 3rd and 4th grade this week. Many of the students were nervous to take it, so I went into all of their classrooms and spoke with the students. My message was pretty simple; do your best!. I told them to do their best and that they don't need to be nervous for two reasons. Reason one, no matter how they do they get to move on to the next grade. Reason two, no matter how they do we (Westside and you their parents) will love them no matter what!

I look at the Forward test as a celebration of all of the students' and teachers' hard work. Many of our students do a great job on the test and score in the advanced and proficient categories. Other students score in the basic and below basic range. Regardless of a child's score, their value at school does not change. Our students are all unique with different learning styles and strengths. Standardized tests will never capture the true value of your child. We use this data the best we can to help your child grow academically, but we view it as a snapshot and a single data point in their journey through school.

Lastly, I want to thank all the 3rd and 4th grade parents for being so accommodating during our testing season! Many parents communicated early about planned absences, are getting their kids extra sleep, and healthy food to be focused so our students can do their best! In other exciting news we hope to see you at our Bingo night next week! It is always a blast!





Classes fill fast! We recommend that you find an alternative class in case your first choice is full. There is **no waiting list**. Should a child drop from a class an opening will be created. It will be the Parent's responsibility to check the website periodically for openings.
