The Kimberly Area School District is dedicated to providing the safest environment for our students and staff. During the 2018-19 school year, schools will be implementing a new secure access system, commonly known as a "buzz-in entry".

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:

- All visitors (including family members, volunteers, and vendors are required to follow the buzz-in procedure during the school day.)
- When you arrive, press the button on the intercom. Guests may be asked to present a government issued ID to the security camera.
- A staff member may ask you some clarifying questions before granting access to the building.
- Once inside, continue to sign in at the office and wear a visitor badge while in the school.
- Anyone unfamiliar with the buzz-in procedure can refer to instructions posted at the main entrance of the school.
- We realize this system will require a change in practice from staff, families, and visitors.
- Thank you for your support as we work to create the safest learning environment possible.
